The applicant requested \$230,500 for the purchase of 60 acres in Anderson County, KY. Central KY ACA in Frankfort, KY is the participating lender.

The applicant requested \$250,000 for the purchase of 35 acres with two (2) Tyson breeder barns in Warren County, KY. Farm Credit Mid-America of Warren county in Bowling Green, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommended approval of the request, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on FCMA and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

AF21-0076 Larimer, Bradley

The applicant requested \$72,500 for the purchase of 40 acres in Hardin County, KY. Farm Credit Mid America in Elizabethtown, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommended approving the request, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on FCMA and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

AF21-0078 Atwell, Ryan

The applicant requested \$130,000 for the purchase of 64 acres in Hart County, KY. South Central Bank of Barren County in Glasgow, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommended approval of the request, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 95% FSA guarantee on South Central Bank and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Dr. Burdine moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented, pending availability of funds; Ms. Rumpke seconded the motion.

AF21-0079 Chesher, Matthew

The applicant requested \$135,790 for the purchase of 59 acres in Henry County, KY. Citizens Union Bank in Shelbyville, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommended approval of the request, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on South Central Bank and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.
