Staff recommended approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on Magnolia Bank and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

## AF22-0003 Howard, Christopher

The applicant requested \$250,000 for the purchase of 24 acres with two (2) Perdue layer houses in Grayson County, KY. Magnolia Bank in Elizabethtown, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommended approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 95% FSA guarantee on Magnolia Bank and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Dr. Burdine moved to approve the committee recommendation, as presented, Mr. Aldridge seconded the motion.

# AF22-0004 Johnson, Lance

The applicant requested \$140,000 for the purchase of 66 acres in Grayson County, KY. Magnolia Bank in Elizabethtown, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommended approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on Magnolia Bank and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Ms. Rumpke moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented, pending availability of funds; Mr. lawson seconded the motion.
