The applicant requested \$250,000 for improvements of two Cobb Vantress layer barns in Wayne County. Farm Credit in Somerset, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on FCMA and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Beginning Farmer Loan Program (BFLP)

AF22-0090 Hatchett, Justin

The applicant requested \$215,825 for the purchase of 94 acres in Washington County, KY. Central Kentucky ACA Lebanon, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on CKACA and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100% with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

AF22-0091 Hulett, Alexandra

The applicant requested \$250,000 for the purchase of 431 acres in Garrad County, KY. Central Kentucky ACA in Danville, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of 90% FSA guarantee on CKACA and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Mr. Penn moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Dr. Burdine seconded the motion

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF22-0092 Wade, James

The applicant requested \$250,000 for the purchase of 110 acres with residence and improvements in Marion County, KY. Lincoln National Bank in Hodgenville, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of 90% FSA guarantee on Lincoln National Bank and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Ms. Rumpke moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Flanagan seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF22-0093 Benton, Clayton

The applicant requested \$200,000 for the purchase of 149 acres and shares in family LLC in Madison County, KY. Central Kentucky ACA in Richmond, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval with combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Dr. Burdine moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Aldridge seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF22-0094 Bush, Ethan

The applicant requested \$94,000 for the purchase of 56 acres with improvements in Owen County, KY. Farm Credit in Lexington, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval with combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Ms. Rumpke moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Flanagan seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed: Unanimous.

AF22-0095 Stevens, Lucas

The applicant requested \$246,250 for the purchase of 89 acres in Anderson County, KY. Central Kentucky ACA of Franklin County in Frankfort, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Mr. Hunt moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Penn seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF22-0097 Robertson, Megan

The applicant requested \$225,000 for the purchase of 82 acres in Hart County, KY. South Central Bank of Barren County in Glasgow, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 85% OR contingent upon the approval and obligation of 90% FSA guarantee on South Central Bank and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Dr. Burdine moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Ms. Rumpke seconded the motion

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF22-0098 Rodriguez, Joseph

The applicant requested \$250,000 for the purchase of 25 acres with two Pilgrim's Pride layer barns in Graves County, KY. River valley AgCredit in Clinton, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon approval and obligation of 90% FSA guarantee on RVACA and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Mr. Flanagan moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Aldridge seconded the motion

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

Old Business:

Commissioner Quarles called on Lane Ryan to present the following extensions and modifications.

Extension

AF22-0062 Cung, Sui

Ms. Ryan presented a memorandum (on file) regarding the above referenced loan. The loan officer indicated that during the walkthrough with the integrator several improvements were identified and required, resulting in a delay in project completion. This request is for a six-month extension for construction to be completed and the loan to be closed. The new expiration date would be May 12, 2023.

Ms. Rumpke moved to approve staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Aldridge seconded the motion.

AF22-0066 Hrin, Van Bawi

Ms. Ryan presented a memorandum (on file) regarding the above referenced loan. The officer indicated that there was a delay in completion of appraisal services which has postponed project completion. This request is for a three-month extension for appraisal services to be completed and the loan to be closed. The new expiration date would be February 12, 2023.

Ms. Rumpke moved to approve staff recommendation, as presented; Dr. Burdine the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.
