Agricultural Infrastructure Loan (AILP)

AF23-0045 Unruh, Cory

The applicant requested \$250,000 for the purchase of 54 acres with 8 poultry barns and equipment in Calloway County. River Valley AgCredit in Clinton, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on RVAC and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value of no greater than 100%.

Mr. Penn moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Ms. Rumpke seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF23-0050 Lyons, James "Alvin"

The applicant requested \$32,500 for a new grain bin with improvements in Scott County. Central Kentucky ACA in Paris, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with combined loan-to-value of no greater than 85%.

Dr. Burdine moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Flanagan seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Mr. Noe Abstained.

Agricultural Processing Loan Program (APLP)

AF23-0055 M & H Enterprises

The applicant requested \$437,000 for the purchase of equipment for feed tub manufacturing in Montgomery County. Gateway Area Development District in Morehead, KY is the participating lender. This application was referred to the Loan Review Committee.

The Loan Review Committee recommend approval of \$437,000 and the application as presented.

Ms. Rumpke moved to approve the committee recommendation, as presented; Mr. Jaggers seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

Beginning Farmer Loan Program (BFLP)

AF23-0043 Allen, William

The applicant requested \$40,000 for purchase of 20 acres in Wayne County. Monticello Banking Company in Monticello, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with combined loan-to-value of no greater than 85%.

Dr. Burdine moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Noe seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF23-0046 Lawless, Michael

The applicant requested \$172,000 for the purchase of 86 acres in LaRue County. Farm Credit in Elizabethtown, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Mr. Hunt moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Noe seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF23-0048 Duh, Van

The applicant requested \$250,000 for the purchase of 50 acres with 8 Tyson Broiler barns in Webster County, KY. Field & Main Bank in Henderson, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on Field & Main Bank and KAFC funds, combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Mr. Penn moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Aldridge seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF23-0049 Dobner, Andrew

The applicant requested \$175,000 for the purchase of 27 acres in Franklin County, KY. Central Kentucky ACA in Frankfort, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Dr. Burdine moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Flanagan seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Mr. Noe Abstained.

AF23-0051 Nissley, Caleb

The applicant requested \$250,000 for the purchase of construction of 2 Tyson Broiler barns Wayne County, KY. Farm Credit in Somerset, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on FCMA and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Mr. Jaggers moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Aldridge seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF23-0052 Marcum, Cordell

The applicant requested \$58,000 for the purchase of 29 acres Garrard County, KY. Central Kentucky ACA in Richmond, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Mr. Flanagan moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Ms. Rumpke seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Mr. Noe Abstained.

AF23-0054 Compton, Thomas

The applicant requested \$200,000 for the purchase of 51 acres Breckinridge County, KY. Magnolia Bank in Elizabethtown, KY is the participating lender. This application was referred to the Loan Review Committee.

The Loan Review Committee recommend approval of the application as presented.

Ms. Rumpke moved to approve the committee recommendation, as presented; Dr. Burdine seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

Diversification through Entrepreneurship in Agribusiness Loan Program (DEALP) AF23-0053 Hamilton, Gary

The applicant requested \$30,000 for the purchase of a drone sprayer unit in Nicholas County, KY. Central Kentucky ACA in Paris, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Mr. Jaggers moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Aldridge seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Mr. Noe Abstained.

Old Business:

Mr. Hughes called on Ms. Randolph to present the following modifications.

Modifications

AF16-0112 Roach, Travis

Ms. Randolph presented a memorandum *(on file)* regarding the above-mentioned loan. The KAFC Board approved Mr. Roach's request for a total of \$250,000 for the purchase of 10 acres in with four Pilgrims Pride boiler barns in Hickman County contingent on the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on RVAC and KAFC funds with a combined loan-to-value of no greater than 100%. The loan officer indicated that

recently one of Mr. Roach's broiler barns burnt in which he will be receiving \$237,000 back from the insurance company and requested approval for the release of the insurance funds to allow Mr. Roach to invest in the purchase and/or improvements of another property. AF16-0112's loan-to-value was 78% at the time of approval and after several years of repayment is at 67% with 107 months of repayment remaining. AF16-0114's loan-to-value was 100% at the time of approval and is currently at 72% with 11 months of loan life remaining.

The Loan Review Committee recommended approval as presented.

Ms. Rumpke moved to approve loan review committee recommendation, as presented; Mr. Noe seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF21-0046 Totman, Nathan

Ms. Randolph presented a memorandum (on file) regarding the above-mentioned loan. The KAFC Board approved Mr. Totman's request for \$130,000 for the purchase of 105 acres in Mercer County contingent on the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on CKACA and KAFC funds with combined loan-to-value of no greater than 100% at the June 11, 2022, meeting. The loan officer indicated that Mr. Totman wishes to purchase a double wide mobile home that will sit on the property and has requested KAFC subordination. The project's combined loan-to-value was 82% at the time of approval. After several years of repayments, if this subordination request is approved the new combined loan-to-value would be 44% with the FSA Guarantee still active.

The Loan Review Committee recommended approval as presented.

Ms. Rumpke moved to approve loan review committee recommendation, as presented; Dr. Burdine seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF14-0062 Davis, Juddson

Mr. McCloskey presented a memorandum (on file) regarding the above-mentioned loan. The KAFC Board approved Mr. Davis's request for \$250,000 for the construction of two Tosh Farms swine barns and purchase of equipment in Marshall County contingent on the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on First Financial Bank and KAFC funds with a combined loan-to-value of no greater than 100% at the July 11, 2014, meeting. The \$250,000 was split between two notes, one for \$125,000 on a 15-year term and another for \$125,000 on a 7-year balloon note on a 10-year amortization. The loan officer indicated Mr. Davis is requesting a modification to extend the 7-year term note out 3 years and fully amortize the loan. The loan matured on March 1, 2023, and has a current balance of \$40,694. The project's combined loan-to-value was 98% at the time of approval and current combined loan-to-value is at 85%.

The Loan Review Committee recommended not to extend the loan terms.

Ms. Rumpke moved to approve loan review committee recommendation, as presented; Mr. Penn seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed: Unanimous.

Closing Remarks

Mr. Hughes informed the board the next KAFC meeting will be at the Franklin County Extension Office on Friday, May 12, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. EDT.
