Agricultural Infrastructure Loan (AILP)

AF23-0047 Harvey, Hawkins

The applicant requested \$250,000 for the construction of two Cobb Vantress layer barns in Metcalfe County. Farm Credit in Glasgow, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on FCMA and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value of no greater than 100%.

Dr. Burdine moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented, Mr. Hunt seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed, Unanimous.

AF23-0064 Moyers, Brian

The applicant requested \$81,500 for the construction and improvements to an equine facility in Simpson County. First Southern National Bank in Stanford, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with combined loan-to-value of no greater than 85%.

Mr. Aldridge moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Noe seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed, Unanimous.

AF23-0065 Bale, Zach

The applicant requested \$25,750 for the construction of a grain bin in Green County. Farm Credit in Campbellsville, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with combined loan-to-value of no greater than 85%.

Mr. Flanagan moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Dr. Burdine seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed: Unanimous.

AF23-0066 Stoltzfus, John

The applicant requested \$250,000 for the construction of an Amish dairy facility in Caldwell County. Independence Bank in Providence, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon documentation of Kentucky proof of residency and combined loan-to-value of no greater than 85%.

Mr. Jaggers moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Aldridge seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF23-0067 Lundy, Dalton

The applicant requested \$65,000 for the construction of a cattle barn in Nelson County. Wilson & Muir Bank & Trust Co in Bardstown, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with combined loan-to-value of no greater than 85%.

Mr. Flanagan moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented, Dr. Burdine seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

Agricultural Processing Loan Program (APLP) AF23-0057 Scruggs, Adam

The applicant requested \$150,000 for the purchase of Adairville Feed Mill in Logan County. Independence Bank in Russellville, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with combined loan-to-value of no greater than 85%.

Dr. Burdine moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Hunt seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

Beginning Farmer Loan Program (BFLP) AF23-0056 Detwiler, Dylan

The applicant requested \$107,100 for purchase of 28 acres in Shelby County. Farm Credit in Shelbyville, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with combined loan-to-value of no greater than 85%.

Mr. Noe moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Aldridge seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF23-0058 Blackburn, Shawn

The applicant requested \$250,000 for the purchase of 116 acres in Fleming County. Magnolia Bank in Elizabethtown, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on Magnolia Bank and KAFC funds and documentation of Kentucky proof of residency, combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Mr. Noe moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Flanagan seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF23-0059 Cubert, Jarrod

The applicant requested \$200,000 for the purchase of 123 acres in Anderson County, KY. Central Kentucky ACA in Frankfort, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on CKACA and KAFC funds, combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Dr. Burdine moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented, Mr. Flanagan seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Mr. Noe Abstained.

AF23-0060 Brown, Spencer

The applicant requested \$110,000 for the purchase of 49 acres in Anderson County, KY. Central Kentucky ACA in Frankfort, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 95% FSA guarantee on CKACA and KAFC funds, combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Mr. Hunt moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Jaggers seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Mr. Noe Abstained.

AF23-0061 Greenwell, Michael

The applicant requested \$50,000 for the purchase of 20 acres in Breckinridge County, KY. Farm Credit in Hardinsburg, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on FCMA and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Mr. Noe moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Jaggers seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF23-0068 Farmwald, Jason

The applicant requested \$148,750 for the purchase of 55 acres in Clinton County, KY. Bank of Columbia in Columbia, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Mr. Aldridge moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Flanagan seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF23-0069 McFarland, Todd

The applicant requested \$250,000 for the purchase of 334 acres in Wayne County, KY. Monticello Banking Company in Monticello, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Dr. Burdine moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Flanagan seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

Diversification through Entrepreneurship in Agribusiness Loan Program (DEALP) AF23-0062 Rayhill. Todd

The applicant requested \$110,000 for the purchase of 13 acres and construction of a commercial building in Casey County, KY. Southeast KY Economic Development Corporation in Somerset, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Mr. Hunt moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Dr. Burdine seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed, Unanimous.

Large Animal Veterinary Loan Program (VET)

AF23-0063 Pike, Andrew

The applicant requested \$250,000 for the purchase of a veterinary clinic in Hart County, KY, Magnolia Bank in Elizabethtown, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Mr. Jaggers moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Noe seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed, Unanimous.

Old Business:

Mr. Hughes called on Ms. Randolph to present the following time extensions.

Extensions

AF23-00116 Bontrager, Steve

Ms. Randolph presented a memorandum (on file) regarding the above-mentioned loan. The KAFC Board approved Mr. Bontrager's request for \$202,500 for the purchase of 23 acres with two Tyson Broiler barns in Wayne County at the February 10, 2023, meeting. The loan officer indicated there have been delays in closing the loan due to the property surveying and title issues. This request is for a three month extension to allow time for property surveying and title services to be completed and the loan to be closed. The new expiration date would be August 10, 2023.

Mr. Flanagan moved to approve staff recommendation, as presented; Dr. Burdine seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF20-0058 Miller, Rustin

Ms. Randolph presented a memorandum (on file) regarding the above-mentioned loan. The KAFC Board approved Mr. Miller's request for \$250,000 for the purchase of 21 acres and construction of four Pilgrim's Pride broiler barns in Graves County at the July 10, 2020, meeting. At the February 10, 2023, board meeting the loan officer indicated there had been delays in closing due to filing and paperwork issues regarding the FSA quarantee; the board approved a three-month extension, pushing the expiration date May 11, 2023.

Currently, the loan officer indicated that there are still delays with FSA office regarding obtaining the FSA guarantee. This request is for a fourth three-month extension for title services and the FSA guarantee to be completed. The expiration date would be August 11, 2023. After discussion the board recommended to give Mr. Miller a six-month time extension for title services and the FSA guarantee to be completed. The new expiration date would be November 11, 2023.

Dr. Burdine moved to approve board recommendation, as presented,

Mr. Flanagan seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF23-0015 Dickerman, James

Ms. Randolph presented a memorandum (on file) regarding the above-mentioned loan. The KAFC Board approved Mr. Dickerman's request for \$250,000 for the purchase of 66 acres with eight Tyson broiler barns in Hopkins County at the February 10, 2023, meeting. The loan officer indicated the applicant is extending his purchase contract. This request is for a three-month extension to allow time for the property surveying and title services to be completed and the loan to be closed. The new expiration date would be August 10, 2023.

Mr. Noe moved to approve staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Hunt seconded the motion.

VOTE Motion Passed, Unanimous,

AF22-0093 Benton, Clayton

Ms. Randolph presented a memorandum (on file) regarding the above-mentioned loan. The KAFC Board approved Mr. Benton's request for \$200,000 for the purchase of 149 acres and shares into the family LLC in Madison County at the November 18, 2022, meeting. The board previously approved one other extension request on behalf of Mr. Benton. At the February 10, 2023 board meeting the loan officer indicated that the project had encountered delays due to titling issues; the board approved a three-month extension, pushing the expiration date on May 18, 2023.

Currently, the loan officer has indicated there have been more delays regarding clearing the title for the farm the applicant is purchasing. This request is for a six-month extension for the issues to be resolved and the purchase completed. The new expiration date would be November 18, 2023.
