The Loan Review Committee recommends pending the application for additional information and referring the application back to the Loan Review Committee.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon documentation of Rural Emergency For America Program grant disbursement, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Ms. Randolph referenced the above application requesting \$132,612 for the construction of a 60,000 bushel grain facility in Calloway County. The Murray Bank in Murray, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 85% and KAFC aggregate balance below \$250,000 at the time of closing.

Ms. Rumpke moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Dr. Burdine seconded the motion.

#### AF23-0188 Payne Brothers Farm LLC

Mr. Roberts referenced the above application requesting \$41,113.15 for the construction of 48'9 ring, 50,000-bushel grain bin in Graves County. River Valley AgCredit in Mayfield, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with aggregate KAFC balance being no greater than \$250,000 for each applicant at the time of closing, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on Citizens Bank and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on Bank of Columbia and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on CKACA and KAFC funds, with combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

#### AF23-0193 Goggin, Logan
