Mr. McCloskey referenced the above application requesting \$47,500 for the purchase of 36 acres in Perry County. Farm Credit Mid-America in Lexington, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with a combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Mr. Flanagan moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Noe seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed: Unanimous.

#### AF24-0138 Myatt, Chad

Mr. Jones referenced the above application requesting \$180,000 for the purchase of 117 acres in Ballard County. First Community Bank of the Heartland in LaCenter, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with a combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Mr. Cochran moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Hunt seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

#### AF24-0140 Jones, John

Mr. Roberts referenced the above application requesting \$224,000 for the purchase of 280 acres in Wayne County. Monticello Banking Company in Monticello, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with a combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Mr. Penn moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Noe seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

#### AF24-0141 Koehn, Donovon

Mr. McCloskey referenced the above application requesting \$250,000 for the purchase of 37 acres with two Pilgrims Pride egg barns in Graves County. River Valley AgCredit in Mayfield, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with a combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Mr. Noe moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Flanagan seconded the motion

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF24-0142 Wilson, David

Mr. Roberts referenced the above application requesting \$250,000 for the construction of a Vital Farms egg barn in Calloway County. River Valley AgCredit in Murray, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with a combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Mr. Jaggers moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Dr. Burdine seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed: Unanimous.

#### AF24-0143 Smith, Damion

Mr. McCloskey referenced the above application requesting \$113,925.50 for the purchase of 41 acres in Fleming County. Central Kentucky ACA in Lexington, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with a combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Mr. Noe moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Hunt seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed: Unanimous.

#### AF24-0144 Partin, Dalton

Mr. Roberts referenced the above application requesting \$113,925.50 for the purchase of 41 acres in Fleming County. Central Kentucky ACA in Lexington, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 95% FSA guarantee on CKACA and KAFC funds, with a combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Dr. Burdine moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Hunt seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed: Mr. Noe Abstained.

#### AF24-0146 Gardner, Chase

Mr. McCloskey referenced the above application requesting \$250,000 for the purchase of 119 acres in Metcalfe County. South Central Bank of Barren County in Glasgow, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on SCB and KAFC funds, with a combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Mr. Penn moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Jaggers seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

## Diversification Through Entrepreneurship In Agribusiness Loan Program (DEALP) AF24-0139 Dyer, Michael

Mr. Jones referenced the above application requesting \$250,000 for the purchase of 200 acres in Pulaski County. Farm Credit Mid-America in Somerset, KY is the participating lender. This application was referred to the Loan Review Committee.

The Loan Review Committee recommends approving subject to the residence being built and being operable.

Mr. Noe moved to approve the committee recommendation, as presented; Dr. Burdine seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

#### AF24-0145 Knoth, Laura

Mr. McCloskey referenced the above application requesting \$222,500 for the purchase of Holly Nursery & Garden Center in Marshall County. First Financial Bank in Benton, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with a combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Mr. Penn moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Aldridge seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

#### **Old Business:**

Deputy Commissioner Beeler called on Mr. Roberts the following modification, time extension, and withdrawn applications.

#### **Modifications**

#### AF24-0124 Kelly, Ty

Mr. Robets presented a memorandum (on file) regarding the above referenced loan. The loan officer is requesting a modification on behalf of Mr. Kelly. The KAFC Board approved Mr. Kelly's request for \$190,000 for the purchase of 35 acres in Scott County at the June 14, 2024, meeting. The borrowers were approved to a 95% FSA guarantee on Central Kentucky Ag Credit and KAFC financing. Due to FSA's definition of a "young beginning farmer", FSA was only able to approve the guarantee at 90%. This request is to lower the FSA guarantee limit from 95% to 90% with improved loan-to-value position.

The Loan Review Committee recommended approval as presented.

Mr. Hunt moved to approve loan review committee recommendation, as presented;

Mr. Cochran seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Mr. Noe Abstained.

#### **Extension**

#### AF24-0013 Thomas, Cory

Mr. Roberts presented a memorandum (on file) regarding the above referenced loan. The loan officer indicated that there have been delays in finalizing the FSA note and delaying closing with FCMA and KAFC. This request is for a three (3) month extension to allow time for FSA to finalize their documentation and close their loan with the borrower. The new deadline would be November 9, 2024.

Mr. Aldridge moved to approve staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Flanagan seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

#### AF24-0022 T&T Feed and Seed

Mr. Roberts presented a memorandum (on file) regarding the above referenced loan. The loan officer indicated that there have been delays in closing the loan due to zoning changes having yet to be voted on by the appropriate committee. This request is for a six (6) month extension to allow time for the zoning request to be approved. The new deadline would be February 10, 2025.

Dr. Burdine moved to approve staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Noe seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion Passed; Unanimous.

AF24-0069 Ragland, Joshua

Mr. Roberts presented a memorandum (on file) regarding the above referenced loan. The loan officer indicated that there have been delays in purchasing the livestock on the part of the borrower as well as delays due to the loan officer being out of town for several weeks. This request is for a three (3) month extension to allow time to purchase the breeding stock. The new deadline would be October 19, 2024.

Dr. Burdine moved to approve staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Cochran seconded the motion.
