Memo Action Items

A2008-0400 Kentucky Agricultural Finance Corporation

Deputy Commissioner Beeler called on Mr. Reed to present a memorandum (on file). The Kentucky Agricultural Finance Corporation (KAFC) Board requests the Kentucky Agricultural Development Board (KADB) to consider the transfer of \$5 million dollars to support the continuation of low-interest loans through the established revolving loan program. Increased outreach, more favorable terms and higher market interest rates has resulted in an increase for 2.75% KAFC loans.

Ms. Noel moved to approve the memorandum on behalf of the Kentucky Agricultural Finance Corporation to the Kentucky Agricultural Development Board; Mr. Penn seconded the motion.

Mr. McCloskey referenced the above application requesting \$250,000 for the construction of two Tyson broiler houses in Monroe County. Farm Credit Mid-America in Glasgow, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on FCMA and KAFC funds, with a combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Mr. Roberts referenced the above application requesting \$150,000 for the construction of a grain bin system in Hardin County. Farm Credit Mid-America in Elizabethtown, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, with a combined loan-to-value no greater than 85%.

Mr. Hunt moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Mr. Jaggers seconded the motion.

Mr. McCloskey referenced the above application requesting \$200,000 for the purchase of forty acres with four Tyson broiler in Warren County. Farm Credit Mid-America in Bowling Green, KY is the participating lender.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on FCMA and KAFC funds, with aggregate KAFC balance no greater than \$250,000 with a combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Mr. Aldridge moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Ms. Rumpke seconded the motion.

Beginning Farmer Loan Program (BFLP)

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 95% FSA guarantee on Field and Main Bank and KAFC funds, with a combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Staff recommends approval, contingent upon the approval and obligation of a 90% FSA guarantee on SCB and KAFC funds, with a combined loan-to-value no greater than 100%.

Mr. Hunt moved to approve the staff recommendation, as presented; Ms. Rumpke seconded the motion.
