As you know, the Kentucky Department of Agriculture (KDA) is tasked with numerous consumer protection responsibilities as it relates to gas stations in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. I wanted to write the Kentucky Petroleum Marketers Association to urge you and your members to take actions that will help reduce the transmission of the COVID-19 (coronavirus) in Kentucky.

We are all still learning about this particular strain of coronavirus, but we do know that it can remain on surfaces many days after initial contact.

Here are some actions the KDA recommends your members consider:

- Sanitation: Many businesses across Kentucky provide hand sanitizer or sanitizing wipes to visitors. We applaud those members who already provide these items to their customers and encourage the members who do not currently provide those items to consider providing them.
- **Pumps and Keypads:** We encourage gas stations and other fueling stations to frequently disinfect pumps and keypads that experience heavy use from consumers.
- Education: I urge you and your members to stay current with the latest information regarding the Coronavirus outbreak.
