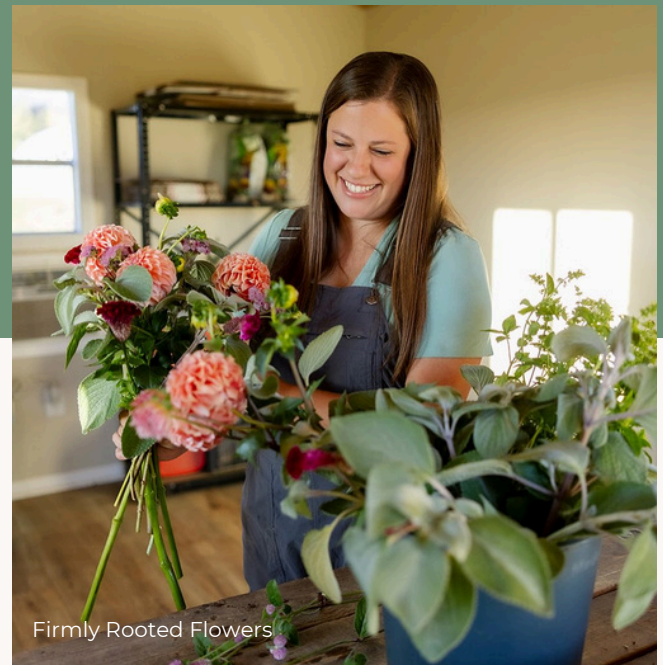
Welcome to the sixth annual KY Proud CSA Week! Thank you for joining us to celebrate Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) across Kentucky. Use this guide to explore participating farms, discover other CSA share types, and find more local food products in your area.

WHAT IS CSA?

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a local farm subscription you sign up for in advance. Members pay for a portion of the share upfront and this helps the farm purchase seeds, labor, and equipment earlier in the growing season. In return, CSA shareholders get access to local products (aka delicious fresh food) on a regular basis and share in the risk and reward of the growing season.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF CSA?

CSA makes it easy to access fresh, locally sourced foods while supporting Kentucky farms. Members can pick up their share at a community location, farmers market, or opt for home delivery to receive a wide variety of local products throughout the growing season, try new recipes, and enjoy healthy meals.

CSA SIGNUP TIPS

Choose a CSA share size that's right for you

Determine the best share size for your household based on the preferred number of items and how often you cook at home. CSA farms typically offer various share sizes (small, regular, extra-large) and different delivery frequencies (weekly, bi-weekly, monthly), allowing members to select both the amount of farm products they receive and the timing throughout the CSA season. Learn more about about the quantity of items included in each share on the farm website.

Prepare for what will be in your CSA share

Look for a description of the products you can expect when signing up for a CSA share. If you're curious about receiving a specific item, contact the farm directly. For produce CSAs, members can expect items to be harvested a few days before pickup and then packed in a box or bag. For meat CSAs, items generally come frozen and are packed in an insulated bag to maintain the proper temperature during pickup. These items can be thawed in the refrigerator for immediate use or stored in the freezer.

Select a payment option for your CSA share

Choose the share payment option that works best for you. Members can often choose to pay in full or in installments. When possible, paying more upfront helps the farm secure critical operating capital early in the season, which is needed to increase production. However, this is not usually required. Some CSA programs also offer sliding-scale payment options to better accommodate various budgets.

Find a CSA pickup that works for your schedule

Explore pickup options and choose the most convenient location, time, and day of the week. CSA shares are typically available for pickup on the farm, at the farmers market, in a neighborhood, or at a business storefront. If none of these options work, some farms also offer home delivery for an additional fee, bringing the CSA share straight to your door. If you're traveling during the season, many farms will also allow a member to pause their share and receive extra items in a future week.

Go to the [Organic Association Find-A-Farm Directory](#) and select the “Find CSA” box to find OAK members that offer a CSA program.




